CHRIST IS RISEN!

Very early on Sunday Morning the women went to the tomb, carrying the spices they had



prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the entrance to the tomb, so they went in; but they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. They stood there puzzled about this, when suddenly two men in bright shining clothes stood by them. Full of fear, the women bowed down to the ground, as the men said to them, "Why are you looking among the dead for one who is alive? He is not here; He has been raised. Remember what He said to you while He was in Galilee: 'The Son of Man must be handed over to sinful men, be crucified, and three days later rise to life.'

Then the women remembered His words, returned from the tomb, and told all these things to the eleven disciples and all the rest. The women were Mary Magdalene, Joanna, and Mary the mother of James; they and the other women with them told these things to the apostles. But the apostles thought that what the women said was nonsense, and they did not believe them. But Peter got up and ran to the tomb, he bent down and saw the grave clothes but nothing else. Then he went back home amazed at what happened.

But the truth is that Christ has been raised from death, as the guarantee that those who sleep in death will also be raised. For just as death came by means of a man, in the same way the rising from death comes by means of a man. For just as all people die because of their union with Adam, in the same way all will be raised to life because of their union with Christ. But each one will be raised in his proper order: Christ, first of all; then, at the time of his coming, those who belong to him. Then the end will come; Christ will overcome all spiritual rulers, authorities, and powers, and will hand over the Kingdom to God the Father. For Christ must rule until God defeats all enemies and puts them under his feet. The last enemy to be defeated will be death. For the scriptures says, "God put all things under his feet." It is clear, of course, that the words, "all things" do not include God himself, who puts all things under Christ. But when all things have been placed under Christ's rule, then He himself, the Son, will place himself under God, who placed all things under Him; and God will rule completely over all.

THE TIME IS NOW

Someday, I'll do something great. Someday, I'll think about others. Someday, when I have more time I'll spend it on my needy brothers. Someday, I will perform great tasks; Do something kind in some big way. My friend....the time is now; Do something small and do it today!
