THE TRAGEDY OF GOSSIP

You will be pleased to learn that only .001% of all deaths occur in worship services in church, and, these are usually related to previous physical disorders. Therefore, logic tells us that the safest place for you to be at any given point in time is at church! Adult Enrichment Class is safe too. The percentage of deaths during these classes is even less.

For safety's sake...attend church! It could save your life!
