#### PRAYER...PRACTICAL

Prayer is the most practical force in the world today. It is the one way to invest your time that pays off because prayer has a strange and wonderful way of fulfilling its own purpose. When you pray you acknowledge your belief in God and that belief itself answers your prayers. When you pray for courage, the very fact you are asking for courage gives you that courage and adds to your strength. When you pray for wisdom, you put yourself in contact with the fount of all wisdom and open your mind for answers. Even as you pray God is placing the answer in your heart.

#### GOD CAN ANSWER PRAYER

There is just the day to day effort to lead others, by our good example, to glorify God.
