FEAST OF PENTECOST



This feast is celebrated fifty days after the Feast of the Resurrection and therefore always falls on Sunday. It is also known by the names, "Whitesunday", "Holy Sunday", "Green Holyday", "Rusalia". This feast was introduced to commemorate the visible descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. The Holy Spirit appeared in the "violent wind" which they heard and in the form of "parted tongues of fire" which they saw. Christ's

wonderful work of Redemption reached completion with this descent of the Comforter. Without doubt this feast has been observed in the Church since Apostolic times. Some churches still decorate the interior with green branches and green flowers and this is why it is called the "Green Holyday" The Pentecostal services clearly prove the divinity of the Holy Spirit beyond all doubt. It is almost paradoxical that in the East where the "filioque" was brought up for discussion, liturgical books profess the true doctrine of the Holy Spirit so clearly. The whole Pentecostal office abounds with such attributes of the Holy Spirit as "He is consubstantial with the Father and the son, and He reigns together with them"...."He is our God..... "He is eternal who always was, is, and will be." In the ikos of the Matins we find "O Christ ..in union with You we sing, and honor you in the Holy Spirit." Were these not conclusive, we might present many other texts which unanimously support the Catholic Doctrine by their trends of thought.

"Let us adore God in three holy persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit...three in one. From all eternity, the Father begets the Son, equal to him in eternity and majesty, equal also to the Holy Spirit, glorified with the Son in the Father, three persons and yet a single power and essence and Godhead."
